

Fellowship Program Designations

All applicants for Full Fellowship must be sponsored by two Full Fellows and approved by the Board of Directors of IACP. There are five types of Fellowship. IACP members can apply for Full, Associate or Academic Fellowship designations. Honorary and Lifetime recipients are nominated by their colleagues.

- Full:** A registered pharmacist who practices the art and skill of compounding and meets all of the experience, educational, practice site, and networking requirements set by the IACP Board of Directors.
- Associate:** A registered pharmacist who practices the art and skill of compounding and who meets the educational and networking requirements set by the IACP Board of Directors. Each applicant for Associate Fellowship must be sponsored by one Full Fellow.
- Academic:** A registered pharmacist who practices the art and skill of compounding and who meets the educational and networking requirements set by the IACP Board of Directors.
- Honorary:** This is open to members who have set a standard of excellence in compounding throughout their career. They have made great contributions to the profession of compounding pharmacy. Honorary Fellows are exempt from the rigorous application and renewal process. This designation is recommended by the Fellowship Committee and approved by the Board of Directors.
- Lifetime:** Lifetime status is reserved for Fellows who have achieved greatness in the field of compounding pharmacy and are about to enter retirement or are already retired. Lifetime Fellows are exempt from the renewal process. This designation is recommended by the Fellowship Committee and approved by the Board of Directors.
